Archbishop Mark has a message for you: I've had a fairly intense few months at the beginning of this year. More than usual seems to have gone wrong, and I've faced a few situations where I've felt close to powerless. I'm sure you know the feeling. Over the years I've learnt not to fret too much over things about which I can do little or nothing. But the pressure is still there. As we celebrate Holy Week and the Easter, I've been thinking of Leonard Cohen's words: "Even though it all went wrong, I'll stand before the Lord of song with nothing on my tongue but Hallelujah". Cohen was Jewish, but his words are deeply Christian, which only goes to show how deeply interwoven Jewish and Christian spirituality are. At times, everything seems to go wrong; but that's not the full story. We see the full story only if we see what God has done and is doing in Jesus crucified and risen. That's why the celebration of Holy Week and Easter are so important. They make praise possible.

Voice in the Wilderness - Easter to Pentecost Discussion Resource: In September 2021, Archbishop Mark Coleridge publicly endorsed the *Uluru Statement From the Heart* and made an historic commitment on behalf of the Catholic Church in the Archdiocese of Brisbane. In partnership with the Edmund Rice Centre, Evangelisation Brisbane have created a resource that invites Catholics to reflect with Christ when reading the *Uluru Statement From the Heart*. Designed to take people on a journey in the weeks between Easter and Pentecost, Voice Crying in the Wilderness includes scripture, prayer, and discussion questions for individuals or groups to engage with the significance of the Uluru Statement and our response to it.
